7U MUCOSAL ATOMIZATION DEVICE (MAD)

PATIENT CARE GOALS

 Rapidly administer guideline specified medications¹ via the intranasal mucosa when vascular access is not available, not indicated or would delay care.

PARAMEDIC

- 1. Following the appropriate guideline, load the syringe with the medication to be administered.
- 2. Attach the mucosal atomization device (MAD) to the syringe.
- 3. Place the MAD approximately 1.5 cm into the nostril, aiming slightly up and outward (toward the top of the ear).
- 4. Briskly compress the syringe plunger to administer half of the medication.
- 5. Remove and repeat in the other nostril to administer the second half of the medication.
- 6. Continue further care per guidelines.

NOTES

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¹ Lorazepam (Ativan), naloxone (Narcan), fentanyl (Sublimaze) and midazolam (Versed) are the only medications approved for administration by this route.
