7W EPIPEN ADMINISTRATION

PATIENT CARE GOALS

• Relieve symptoms of severe allergic reaction, anaphylaxis, asthma, or allergic reaction related bronchospasm with severe symptoms.

EMT

- 1. If the need to administer **EpiPen** is determined by guideline, verify medication is correct dosage¹ has not expired, and is clear and not discolored. May use service supplied or patient's own **EpiPen**.
- 2. Describe procedure to patient and obtain consent if possible.
- 3. Pull off safety cap.
- 4. Wipe injection site with alcohol.
- 5. Place tip of EpiPen on exposed thigh (anterior or lateral) at right angle to leg².
- 6. Press hard into thigh until auto injector mechanism triggers, and hold in place for several seconds.
- 7. Remove **EpiPen** and place in sharps container.
- 8. Massage injection site for 10 seconds to enhance absorption.
- 9. Record actions and reassess in two minutes.

NOTES

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¹ Adults (>60 lbs): 1:1,000 epinephrine (Adrenalin) 0.3 mg IM (one EpiPen Adult)
Children (<60 lbs): 1:2,000 epinephrine (Adrenalin) 0.15 mg IM (one EpiPen Junior)

² May be administered through clothing if patient condition does not permit clothing removal.
