RE: Proposed Tax Levy Certification

Summary:

On or before September 30, 2022, the Board must adopt a proposed budget and levy for FY2023 and certify them to the County Auditor. At the June 15, 2022, South Metro Fire Board meeting, the Board adopted a budget that included a levy of \$1,209,952.

The Minnesota Department of Revenue's Truth in Taxation guidelines do not require special taxing districts to conduct Truth in Taxation public meetings. The Board can adopt the final tax levy payable in 2023 at its regular meeting scheduled for November 16th.

Recommendation:

Affirm adoption of the proposed budget and levy for 2023 and direct staff to certify them to the County Auditor prior to the September 30th deadline.

Resolution Number 2022-01

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE PROPOSED 2023 TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2012, the cities of South St. Paul and West St. Paul entered into a Joint and Cooperative Agreement for an Emergency Medical Services Special Taxing District (hereinafter the "EMS Taxing District" or the "District") and established a Board of Directors to govern, oversee, equip and manage the EMS Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the EMS Taxing District is authorized to levy a tax on the taxable real and personal property in the EMS Taxing District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the EMS Taxing District has agreed to set the 2023 levy at \$1,209,952; and

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. §275.065 requires special taxing districts to adopt and certify to the Dakota County Treasurer/Auditor a Proposed Tax Levy and to notify the Dakota County Treasurer/Auditor of the Proposed Tax Levy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Directors of the EMS Taxing District approves the following:

- 1. \$1,209,952 is established as the proposed tax levy payable in 2023 for the EMS Taxing District.
- 2. Appropriate staff is directed to certify the tax levy to the Dakota County Treasurer/Auditor.
